

## Yamaha Drive G29 Upper Brush Guard Installation Instructions Part# 6294









- 1. Remove the rear basket and top from the cart.
- 2. Slide the rear loop (ITEM A) behind the seats as shown in picture 1.
- 3. Mount the rear brackets (ITEM F) to both seat backs using the supplied M8-1.25x20 bolts as shown in picture 1.
- 4. Loosely mount the rear brackets (ITEM F) to the rear loop using the rear clamps (ITEM G) as shown in picture 1.
- 5. If your cart does not have a top remove the rubber grommets on both sides of the front cowl where the stock top supports would mount. \*\*NOTE\*\* If you are installing a Jake's front brush guard you must install it before you move to step 6!
- 6. Using the supplied spacers (ITEM E) and supplied M8-1.25x70 bolts, mount the front posts (ITEM C) to the stock front top support location as shown in picture 2.
- 7. Mount the main frames (ITEM B) to both the front posts (ITEM C) using the supplied 7/16x2 ¼ bolts, washers & locknuts.
- 8. Mount the cross supports (ITEM D) to the main frames (ITEM B) using the supplied 7/16x2 ¼ bolts, washers & locknuts.

  \*\*NOTE\*\* The front cross support angles to the front and the rear cross support angles to the rear.
- 9. Securely tighten all nuts and bolts.
- 10. Reinstall basket if wanted.
